ESSENTIALS OF WATER AUDITS A water audit is an accounting procedure that monitors where and how much water enters and leaves a water system This allows the assessment of current usage, provides data needed to reduce water and revenue losses, and allows forecasts of future water needs

Leak Detection Methods - ThomasNet

The water-immersion bubble test, also called "bubble testing" or "dunking", is a traditional and relatively primitive technique of leak detection It consists of immersing a charged or pressurized part, usually with high-pressure dry air or nitrogen, in a water tank and watching for escaping bubbles The larger and more
